3 - PreK

Cubbies celebrates the spiritual potential of preschoolers (3-5-year olds) by helping them develop respect for God, His Son and His Word.

The Cubbies curriculum features fun stories and lovable characters that appeal to preschoolers. The handbooks combine basic Scripture memory with activities to help Cubbies grasp simple biblical truths.



K - 2nd

Sparks ignites the curiosity of early elementary-age kids to learn about the people and events of the Bible through memory verse drills and learning key doctrines and Bible facts, building a foundation of wisdom for knowing Christ.



3rd - 6th

T&T engages kids by answering their questions about God and the Bible, guiding them through this pivotal life stage to grow in Christ's grace. Lessons teach that the Bible is true and they can firmly trust what it says.



7th - 12th

Trek challenges students to wrestle with the three most important questions:

- Who am I?
- Why am I here?
- Who's with me?

By allowing students to dive deep into the Scriptures and answer these questions we help them to own their faith & discover what they believe.



Parents

We encourage you to learn with your child. Participate in club time with your child, helping them through their handbooks, lessons, and activities. Additionally, we will send home a review sheet each week, so you can help your child to continue to grow and learn.

Registration/Check In

Help parents and kids register and check in each week.

Handbook Helpers

SCHEDULE
